What is Safe Home?

The Safe Home training program addresses the unique barriers that vulnerable older adults face in accessing the care they need in the state of Washington.

Our skill-based training courses provide staff the tools they need to be able to meet the mandate of providing person centered care in long term care facilities.

Our courses ensure staff develop specific and transferable skills that will result in more inclusive care for health disparate, underserved populations.

Safe Home offers:

- Technical assistance on best practices for supporting LGBTQ+ older adults
- Ongoing training centered around the needs of your long-term care community
- Access to Goldsen Institute research on vulnerable populations
- Resources, guides, and reports on issues related to LGBTQ+ aging

Eligibility & Cost

The Safe Home training program is offered at no-cost to Skilled Nursing Facilities in Washington State. CEUs and Certificate of Completion will be provided. There is a nominal training fee for other Long-Term Care Providers.
